Greetings from the Indian School of Business & Finance (ISBF), New Delhi!

This email contains information about ISBF's admissions policy, so we would request you to please share it with the school's Career Counselling team, if it hasn't reached there already.

We would like to inform you that applications are now open for the undergraduate intake of 2019 for the following programmes:

**BSc Economics | BSc Economics & Finance | BSc Accounting & Finance | BSc Economics & Management | BSc Business & Management | BSc Management & Digital Innovation**

As you may already know, ISBF is an Affiliate Centre of University of London and one of the select few "featured" Teaching Institutions of The London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE) in the world. As such, all programmes offered at ISBF receive academic direction from LSE, which means that LSE academicians design the curriculum, formulate the syllabi, write the study material, and set and assess the final examinations for all courses on the programmes. It also means that ISBF students are held to LSE's own lofty standards, and this makes their undergraduate degree, awarded by University of London, recognised and valued around the world.

The 2019 Admissions Policy is [attached here](#) – please do read through it carefully, as there are some changes from the previous year. In particular, we would like to draw your attention to the fact that there are 120 seats across all degree programmes, and we follow a rounds-based rolling admissions policy.

In every Admission Round, the process comprises of three steps –

**Step 1:** Filling the Application Form

**Step 2:** Appearing for the ISBF entrance test (IMET), based on which candidates will be shortlisted for Step 3

**Step 3:** Appearing for the Personal Interview (PI)

Once all three steps are completed, a candidate's application will be reviewed by the Admissions Committee. The final admission decision will take into consideration the IMET score (weighted - 50%), performance in the PI (weighted - 30%) and Class XII Board examination scores (weighted - 20%), where available.
